



CODE OF PRACTICE & CONDUCT FOR PARENTS AND CARERS

The SSBA requests all parents and carers conduct themselves to provide an atmosphere and culture that encourages fair play and promotes badminton.

- 1 Encourage your child to learn the rules of the association and abide by / play within them.
 - 2 Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
 - 3 Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
 - 4 Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
 - 5 Never force your child to take part in sport.
 - 6 Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
 - 7 Publicly accept officials' judgements or decisions.
 - 8 Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy badminton.
 - 9 Encourage your child to enter SSBA organised and external national circuit tournaments within their age group and appropriate standard.
 - 10 Provide encouragement and support for your child at tournaments and events in an appropriate manner, which does not give technical assistance to your child or in any way causes any intimidation of any junior opponent of your child.
 - 11 Use correct and proper language at all times.
 - 12 Encourage and guide your child to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
 - 13 Ensure your child arrives on time for training sessions and events. Should you not be staying with your child then always ensure that the training session or match is definitely taking place before leaving your child and also ensure that you are back in good time to collect them.
 - 14 Ensure your child's fees are paid promptly by the due date.
